YOUR GIVING HAS RESULTS! Our 2017 general budget is \$124,048. So we need around \$10,337 monthly to fully fund our ministries. You may hear talk about something called apportionments. That's UMC lingo for "A PORTION" of each offering "MEANT" for the work of the church in Virginia and around the world. Each church family has their fair share! For us, it means a little over \$500 a week to fund our 2017 apportionments!

But some of this benefits us right here! Our single largest apportionment item is \$221 a week for "ACTIVE CLERGY HEALTH." This means your pastor's health insurance plan is funded through shared apportionments and not through a bill. This is a great help to smaller churches! "We are all in this together!" (Pastor Robert says a big THANK YOU, since this provides him a direct benefit! YOUR GIVING HAS RESULTS!)
