TURNING WISHES INTO REALITY – SOME IDEAS!

- Pray daily for your neighborhood.
- Go outdoors and do a prayer walk.
- Invite someone to join you for coffee at a "Pastor Out and About!"
- Have a church group or gathering in a public place instead of in the church building.
- Talk to others in your community, and ask where the needs are.
- Contact a friend or neighbor, inviting them to coffee, or to lunch, or to a volunteer opportunity, like packing backpacks for MPES! (Remember some people will say YES to serving before saying YES to the church service!)
- Start a small neighborhood prayer circle or Bible study. It doesn't have to be big, and it doesn't have to be "official!"
- Don't just send "get well" cards to those who are ill. Send cards of blessing and encouragement to those may be searching spiritually.

"THANKS" TO ALL WHO SERVE - Sunday, January 22, we will honor and dedicate all who serve and lead, including our church leaders and officers and anyone who has a place of serving in 2017. This is how our church family lives out its mission of making disciples! This is the shared work of ministry!

EXTENDING THE COMMUNION TABLE - If you know of someone who cannot attend on Communion Sunday, but would like someone to bring them Communion on Sunday offering, please let Pastor Robert know. We have trained servers available to help with this! (Let Robert know if you would like to be trained.)

IN CASE OF SNOW AND ICE... - Thanks to our "snow angels," only once in the past three winters have we had to completely cancel Sunday worship. That was a day in 2014 when roads were icing on Sunday morning. We try to use Channel 7 and Channel 10 to announce if there is a closing. (But note that there is more than one MPUMC in the viewing area!) You can also access this information on their web sites (WDBJ and WSLS). Most Sundays we will continue to have worship, even if some can't make it. PLEASE use good sense and discretion if roads are hazardous in your area. Your pastor will ALWAYS make every effort to open the doors for anyone who shows up!

IF we must cancel worship (or if numbers are very small due to travel conditions), we will give a try at doing worship by Facebook Live on my personal page. Never done it before — so no guarantees — and remember that there may also be interruptions to cell service — but we'll try! And if we must cancel worship, depending on travel conditions, we will try to open the doors at 5:00 p.m. the next day (Monday) for anyone who wishes to gather for an informal time of praise and prayer! We'll do our best to make weekly gathering available for you!

BACKPACK PROGRAM - It's hard to believe, but it's January and our time again to pack the bags of food for the children at Mt. Pleasant School! We really need your help! There is a sign-up sheet in the sanctuary for those who are interested in helping. It's great fellowship, too.
