We hope to move to our new site before the end of the year to avoid the increasing amount for rent and to establish the Learning Centre to help mankind. We love you all, and may the Lord bless you. I really can't believe that July 2018 has rolled around! This is a big moment for me as it marks my official retirement as a UMC pastor. However, as you know, it is a sort of a "fake news" retirement, as I continue to serve as your pastor – now as a "three-

fourths time" (30 hours a week) pastor instead of a "full-time" pastor.

We have tried to explain what this means, but it can still be confusing to some. An important shift for me will be to be very intentional about my "day off" each week. Of course full time pastors normally take a day off, but I have been rather flexible (or maybe "disorganized") about mixing my "on time" and my "off time." Mondays will be my new DAY OFF when I will normally be disengaged from pastor roles! (When Monday is a major holiday, my day off will fall on Tuesday.) Most of my during-the-week ministry work will focus Tuesday through Thursday. There will always be exceptions, and pastors are ALWAYS "on call" 24/7 for emergency ministry needs, even when you are "part time!"

Mount Pleasant UMC folks have always been easy to work with, and I expect this to be an easy and healthy adjustment. Nevertheless, if you have questions or issues or suggestions, please let me know!
