Backpack ministry update...

School is just around the corner, and it's time again to plan for the Backpack Program at Mt. Pleasant Elem. Students are starting back earlier this year. August 13 is the first day and we are planning to send home food the following week.

The program provides food each week for about 40 students who have little or no food to eat on the weekends. We combine our efforts with the Lions Club, Brookhill, Rockingham Court, MP Baptist and Bedrock Roanoke to meet this growing need.

HOW CAN WE HELP? Each group has certain items they are responsible for providing in the bags. Our church provides Beanee-Weenees (individual servings), the small individual boxes of cereal, and Mac & Cheese (individual microwave servings).

You can help by donating these items or by making a monetary donation. The cost of these items for one child is \$2.24 a week or \$8.96 a month. Please make checks payable to Mt. Pleasant UMC and mark for "Backpack Program." Please remember that this program is supported by your "above and beyond" giving. It is not a part of our general budget. It is a mission for us!

You can also help by signing up to pack the bags of food at Mt. Pleasant Elementary School. We will be packing the months of August and September. There is a sign-up sheet in the sanctuary.

Packing is usually done on Wednesdays at 9:30, but we can pack any day, other than Friday. They just have to be ready to go on Thursday by noon. You will definitely receive a blessing.
