- 4. Don't use social media as a forum to bash others. Let's act like real people may actually see what we write. Let's post in a way which encourages and builds each other up.
- 5. Develop our patience muscle. What if we thought about the common things which test our patience and asked God to help us deal with it BEFORE we experience it each time?
- 6. Remember that it's not about us. What if we valued others and demonstrated that to them by how we treat them, what we say to them, our facial expressions, or even our thoughts?
- 7. Listen more than we speak. It's hard to value others when we are doing all the talking. It's also hard to hear from God! When we listen, it guards the tongue, protects relationships, and we might actually learn something!
